

National Peer to Peer ROMA Train-the-Trainer Classroom Session (Phase II) Agenda in Brief

Day One 8:30 to 5:00

The first day will open with an overview of the history of the NPtP project, a snapshot of current activities, and discussion of the training and certification process.

- Module 6: Evaluating Performance Using Outcomes and Indicators
- Module 7: Managing Performance with the Logic Model
- Module 8: Financial Dimension of Accountability

We will discuss each module and identify key points for each module.

Day Three 8:30 to 5:00

All candidates will present two modules, each 30 min in length, beginning on the second day. (Note: No one will be scheduled to present two modules in one day.)

There are 8 presentations each on Day Two and Day Three. Assignments will be sent out as Candidates complete the e-course.

Feed back and helpful suggestions will be provided to candidates to help improve both understanding of concepts and presentations.

Master Trainers/Mentors will be available in the evenings of Day One and Day Two to assist in preparation of presentations and to help plan for practices sessions following the Train-the-Trainer event.
